#### 课程简介:

《中文》第三册是在前两册的基础上增加了课文和生字的难度。学生除了完成课本的学习内容以外,复 习巩固以前所学的拼音、偏旁部首和标点符号等基本知识至关重要。在学生前两册学习的基础上,第三 册教学注意听说能力及认字能力并重,同时开始培养基本的写作能力。要求熟练朗诵及背诵所有课文, 熟练掌握本册 159 个生字。这是打好学中文基础的重要环节。 本课程我将采用中文授课,同时配有部 分英文解释,例如生词讲解。除此之外,第三册的教学还增加了《汉语拼音》的内容。课本的编排通过 图画, 音节和汉字的对照, 着重于提高学生认读汉字的能力。鉴于学生已经具备的中文基础, 本课程教 师会尽量多的使用中文教学, 尽可能给学生创造浓厚的中文学习环境, 英文只用来辅助和解释说明。

- 学生应掌握课文的生字词:会读写以及正确的应用生字词
- 听懂教师普通话授课以及日常口语对话。
- 用简单中文回答问题,用课文指定句型及词汇口头造句。
- 能流利朗读课文,并能读懂程度相当的课外文章大意。
- 会用学过的字组词,造句;能写50-100字左右的日常短文。
- 巩固汉语拼音,偏旁部首和标点符号的用法。

#### **Introduction:**

Chinese Book Three is the continuation of the previous textbook with higher level of Chinese language learning in terms of new lessons and new characters. Besides learning new lessons, students will also review and enhance what they have learned in the past such as Pinyin, components of Chinese character and punctuation. Chinese Book Three will focus on the student's capability of speaking and listening as well learning Chinese characters. This capacity will be expanded to cover Chinese composition. It is required the students need to read and recite the lessons fluently. There are 159 new characters in this textbook which are building blocks for learning Chinese. We will use Chinese in the process of teaching Chinese lessons with some explanations in English to help the students understand the contents of the lessons. We will add Pinyin (pronunciation) in Chinese Book Three. The textbook uses graphics, syllables and word comparisons to enhance the student's character recognition. Due to the current level of the students who have already mastered a substantial level of Chinese language, the teacher will use as much Chinese as possible throughout the teaching so as to create a positive Chinese learning environment and use English only when it is necessary when explaining some crucial information.

- Students need to memorize the new characters: Students will be able to read, write, and use those new characters
- Students will understand spoken Chinese and daily conversations.
- Students learn how to answer simple questions in Chinese and use the sentence patterns to make new sentence orally.
- Students will be able to read the lessons fluently and understand the main ideas of the texts beyond the lessons in the textbook.
- Students will learn how to use phrases, sentence making and write an essay of 50-100 characters.
- Review Pinyin, components of Chinese characters and punctuation.
